

Buy One, Give One

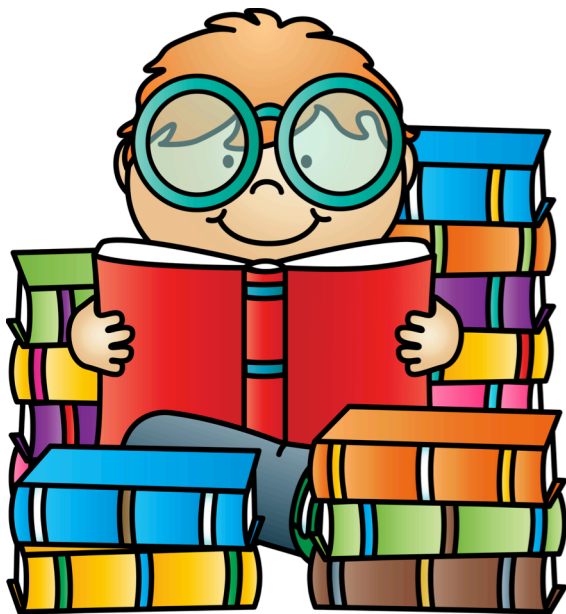
Dear Parents,
